Feb 2024 Update on Waiting Time: 8 - 12 weeks (likely to increase)

No secondary wait for medication (if required)

How to Get an Assessment: ask the GP to refer (we have a referral template set up)

Documents Required: ADHD self report scale & risk assessment questionnaires (found on website)



Right to Choose assessments are funded by the NHS, so there would be no cost attached to the assessment.

You would only be required to pay for prescriptions, which would be at your regular NHS price or exemption.

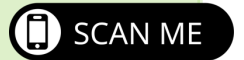

Feb 2024 Update on Waiting Time: 5 to 6 months

How to Get an Assessment: visit the website above to contact the service who will discuss your child's eligibility and forward the required documents to you

Documents Required: Autism self report form and school report



You must remain under the secondary care service in order to continue with medication.

If you are no longer reviewed by the secondary care team, the Shared Care Agreement for medication will no longer be active.
